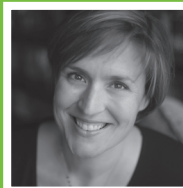

Latham published her first novel, a young adult mystery called *Scarlett Under Cover*, in 2015. In February 2017, she published *Dreamland Burning*, a carefully researched and sensitively written novel about the Tulsa Race Riot. Leite is a memoirist, cookbook author, food writer and publisher of the James Beard Award-winning website Leite's Culinaria. His newest book, *Notes on a Banana: A Memoir of Food, Love, and Manic Depression*, was published in April. His first book, *The New Portuguese Table*, won the 2010 IACP Julia Child Award, as well as garnering other distinctions. Leite is a frequent television guest, and a correspondent and guest host for National Public Radio's "The Splendid Table."
